This year, the Booker Middle School VPA Drama Department will have the opportunity to audition to compete and/or participate in the Florida State Junior Thespian District and State Festivals. The purpose of this packet is to relay the details regarding auditioning and registration information for the festivals.

Each Jr. Thespian troupe is only allowed to enter a certain number of students for each event (i.e. 5 Monologues, 5 Duet Acting, etc.). We are holding audition sessions for the spots for the individual events on **Tuesday**, **September 22**nd **afterschool from 2:30-4:30**. Any student who is interested in competing at the District Festival MUST audition on this day. Each student will be evaluated by a panel using the festival adjudication rubrics. The top students in each event will represent us at the district festival. Students who will not be competing are still encouraged to attend the Festival and observer passes are available (details to follow).

BASIC AUDITION INFORMATION

- 1. Students will be expected to initially find and prepare their Festival selections on their own. Students selected for Festival performances will be expected to attend afterschool rehearsals to rehearse with Ms. Mills.
- 2. Students must time the entirety of their pieces to make sure they do not go over the maximum time allotted per event. See www.fljrthespian.com/infoweb/ for individual event details.
- 3. Students will perform only <u>one minute</u> of the piece they intend to perform at Festival for the auditions, utilizing all props, accompaniments, etc. needed for that part of the piece. These will be provided by the student.
- 4. Auditions will be adjudicated by a panel and will utilize the adjudication rubrics used at both the District and State Festivals.
- 5. The list of students selected to perform at Festival will be posted in Ms Mills' room by the end of the audition week.

BASIC FESTIVAL INFORMATION

THE RULES

- No student may enter the same category twice.
- Students can participate in up to four IE's where ONE must be technical. If they do not do a technical event, then the max is 3 performance events.
- Materials must be drawn from published plays written for the theatre or a published monologue anthology. Poetry, fiction, screenplays, and lyrics will not be allowed.
- Students receiving a Superior rating at the District level are eligible to perform at
 the State level. Final selection will be the sponsor's decision. Each year a
 number of students receiving an Excellent MAY be allowed to attend. Please
 check your State registration packet for details. [STUDENTS WHO QUALIFY
 WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND THE STATE LEVEL FESTIVAL]
- No changes or additions after registration deadline. Dropping an IE will cost \$10.00 per event.
- All Individual Events presented at State Festival must be the same title and cutting, with the same participants, that received an Excellent or Superior at District Festival. Any exceptions to this rule require a written request to the State Director two weeks prior to the Festival.
